Delicate and crisp with fresh floral and citrus notes

Sauvignon Blanc, Giesen, Marlborough,  
New Zealand \$6(g), \$20(b)  
Rich tropical fruit with gooseberry and lemongrass

Sauvignon Blanc, Crossings,  
New Zealand \$7(g), \$28(b)  
Medium bodied with kiwi, lime, and grapefruit

Chardonnay, Kendall Jackson,  
Vintner's Reserve, California \$9(g), \$33(b)  
Tropical notes with a hint of vanilla and toasted oak

Chardonnay, Mossback,  
Russian River \$10(g), \$36(b)  
Bright citrus with notes of green apple, melon  
and hints of spice

Caposaldo Split, Prosecco, Italy \$8(g)  
Bright citrus, green apple and acacia flowers

La Marca, Prosecco, Italy \$35(b)  
Honey and grapefruit with hints of toast

Sofia, Blanc de Blancs, Monterey County \$33(b)  
Crisp apple, melon and tangerine  
with hints of honey

Reds

Pinot Noir, Angeline, California \$7(g), \$25(b)  
Luscious red fruits, spiced tea, sweet oak

Merlot, Leese-Fitch, California \$8(g), \$30(b)  
Bold dark fruit with exotic oak and brown sugar

Spellbound Cabernet Sauvignon,  
California \$9(g), \$28(b)  
Lush, bold, blackberry, cassis, plum, currant and a hint of oak and spice

Cabernet, 14 Hands, Washington \$8(g), \$26(b)  
Medium-bodied, soft in mouth feel, yet long on fruit character and finish

Zinfandel, Boneshaker, Lodi \$9(g), \$36(b)  
Dried plums, black cherry jam and a hint of vanilla incense

Malbec, Dona Paula, Mendoza \$7(g), \$28(b)  
Black peppered fruit, crushed cherries, and hints of anise

Syrah, Alexander Valley Vineyards,  
California \$10(g), \$37(b)  
Dark chocolate and blackberry compote with hints of vanilla bean

Petite Sirah, The Crusher, Clarksburg \$30(b)  
Velvety structure with lush dark fruit, roasted coffee, and dried fig

7 Deadly Red Blend, Lodi California \$10(g), \$32(b)  
Dangerously delicious, blackberry, cherry, clove spice, hints of campfire  
smoke, vanilla undertones, well balanced with a rich finish

House Wines

Chardonnay, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon,  
White Zinfandel \$5(g)

Preserve Gems

Los Carneros Chardonnay, Oberon, Napa Valley 2015 \$45(b)  
Balanced fruit, lingering acidity, rich flavors and aromas of caramelized white pear,  
fresh fuji and golden delicious apple, apple blossoms and torched crème brûlée

Sonoma Cutrer, Chardonnay, Russian River Ranches 2012 \$40(b)  
Aromas of green apple, lime and pineapple, crisp, bright acidity

Diora, Pinot Noir, La Petite Grace, Monterey County 2013 \$40(b)  
Black cherry, dark chocolate, spice and coffee bean unfold with earthy undertones of mushroom and truffle

Emmolo, Merlot, Napa Valley 2014 \$50(b)  
Expansive on the palate with lush dark fruits, hints of cigar box and rich earth, with leathery tannins

Chateau Ste. Michelle, Ste. Michelle Vineyards, Cabernet Sauvignon, Washington, 2015 \$30(b)  
This is an inviting Cab with plenty of complexity and structure with silky tannins

St. Francis Winery & Vineyards, Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley 2014 \$65(b)  
Rich and full-bodied Cabernet with deep, layered aromas and concentrated flavors of  
dark cherry, blueberry, vanilla bean and tobacco. Firm, structured tannins and a luxurious, lingering finish.

Rombauer, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 2014 \$90(b)  
Aromas of vanilla and violet, dense black fruits with subtle smoke on the palate. Powerful, but elegant.

Girard, Old Vine Zinfandel, Napa Valley 2012 \$45(b)  
Loaded with ripe, jammy fruit, well structured, black cherry, toasty oak and spice aromas

Red Schooner by Caymus, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina NV \$49(b)  
Dark and dense with supple red fruits with well-integrated oak and rustic elegance
